### interRAI New Zealand Governance Board

The Ministry of Health is seeking expressions of interest from suitable applicants for the following positions on the interRAI NZ Governance Board:

- Aged residential care provider representative

- Research.

The role of members is to ensure the interRAI NZ Governance Board works collaboratively to progress the dissemination of evidence based interRAI outcomes with key stakeholders including Aged Residential Care and Home and Community Care sectors, Consumer Groups, District Health Boards and the Ministry of Health.

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### Term of Appointment

The appointment is for an initial period of two to three years, with eligibility for re-appointment.
